The Belgian Embassy in Canberra was designed by a team of architects called **Fowell Mansfield & Maclurcan**. The embassy is built in a **mid-century modern** style. This means it has clean shapes, simple lines, and looks calm and elegant. The design fits in with Canberra's special "Diplomatic Hill," where many embassies are located. It has two main parts: The residence – where the ambassador lives, and the chancery – where the embassy staff work.
