



The High Court of Australia, 1980

The High Court of Australia is a big, important building in Canberra. It was opened on May 26, 1980, by Queen Elizabeth II. The building was designed by a group of architects called **Edwards Madigan Torzillo and Briggs**.

The building's style is called **Brutalist** architecture. This means it uses bold shapes and lots of concrete, giving it a strong, powerful look—almost like a giant fortress.
