How to make pots out of toilet paper rolls

These are easy, fun, free and fully biodegradable – what's not to love? Make sure you remind everyone in the house to save toilet rolls!

What you will need:







Scissors



Soil



Seeds

Instructions:



1. Take one toilet roll and





2. Then turn at right angles and squash flat again. This gives you a guide for cutting



3. Cut in about 1-2 cm along the four fold lines you made in step 2



4. Fold each of the four flaps to make a sharp crease



5. Fold in each flap over the other, tucking the last one under the first to secure



6. And ther you have your toilet paper roll pot.

Once you have made your pot, fill it with soil and sow your seeds. When they are big enough, you can plant it directly in the garden, pot and all, because the cardboard will break down quickly.
